

Thailand Re-Entry Permit Guide (Deutsch & English)

Wichtige Regeln für Re-Entry-Permit in Thailand (Deutsch)

Grundregel:

Wer ausreist, verliert automatisch sein Visum, wenn kein gültiges Re-Entry-Permit vorhanden ist.

Welche Visa brauchen ein Re-Entry-Permit?

- Touristenvisum (Single Entry): Ja
- Non-Immigrant O, B, ED (einmalige Einreise): Ja
- Non-Immigrant O-A / O-X (Rentenvisa, Multiple Entry): Nein (wenn Multiple Entry ausgestellt)
- Thailand Elite Visa: Nein
- Permanent Resident: Kein Re-Entry, aber Endorsement nötig
- Marriage Visa (Non-Immigrant O, Multiple Entry): Nein

Kosten:

- Single Re-Entry: 1.000 Baht (~26 EUR)
- Multiple Re-Entry: 3.800 Baht (~100 EUR)

Wo beantragen?

- Immigration Office (vor Abreise) oder Flughafen (vor Passkontrolle)

Wichtig:

- Keine nachträgliche Beantragung nach Ausreise möglich!

Important Re-Entry Permit Rules for Thailand (English)

Basic rule:

If you leave Thailand, your visa will automatically expire without a valid Re-Entry Permit.

Which visas need a Re-Entry Permit?

- Tourist Visa (Single Entry): Yes

- Non-Immigrant O, B, ED (Single Entry): Yes
- Non-Immigrant O-A / O-X (Retirement Visa, Multiple Entry): No (if issued as Multiple Entry)
- Thailand Elite Visa: No
- Permanent Resident: No Re-Entry needed, but Endorsement required
- Marriage Visa (Non-Immigrant O, Multiple Entry): No

Fees:

- Single Re-Entry: 1,000 Baht (~26 EUR)
- Multiple Re-Entry: 3,800 Baht (~100 EUR)

Where to apply?

- Immigration Office (before departure) or Airport (before passport control)

Important:

- No retroactive application possible after leaving Thailand!
